Post; missing.

16" Hemlock bears N24W 19 lks.; now a 24" x 30" high badly
rotted stump with no scribes visible, bears N13W
12.5 ft.

8" Hemlock bears N57E 49 lks.; missing, point falls in old
cat road.

RESTORATION by Richard A Morris LS401, October 17, 1960 (Book 2,
page 459, Tillamook Co. Records.)

1 1/2"x36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap, 33" in
ground, in mound of stone; in place, on north edge of old
cat road, course N44E by S68W.

34" Fir stump bears N77E 36.2 ft.; now rotted with scribes
1/4 S36 BT visible.

28" Fir stump bears N11 1/2W 15.0 ft.; now badly rotted with
face laying alongside with scribes 1/4 S35 BT visible.

4"x4"x72" white painted Cedar post 1.0 ft. NE of pipe; now
rotted and out of place.

From above pipe with marks "LS1998 1993" added, a:

10" Fir bears N84E 26.7 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S36BT.

15" Fir bears S33 1/2E 21.9 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S36BT.

21" Fir bears S88 1/2W 36.0 ft. to face; scribed 1/4S35BT.

Metal location poster on new BTs.

3/4" brass washer marked "LS1998" nailed to face of new BTs.
