

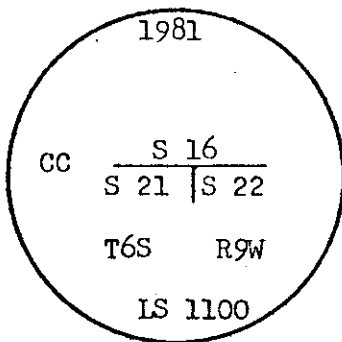
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE <sup>9</sup> WEST

Closing Corner, Sections  $\frac{16}{21/22}$ , T6S, R9W

Found the following evidence which matches original G.L.O. notes:  
80" cedar stump bears S 10° W 14.52 feet; face with overgrowth,  
added yellow tag

- Creek calls: 1) 25 lks. wide, course NW, 151 feet south 1
- 2) 25 lks. wide, course NW, 69 feet west

Set 1" x 3/4" iron pipe in pile of stones for the corner with a brass cap marked as illustrated:



From which:

- 12" hemlock bears N 29° E 46.82 feet; 8" bridge spike, yellow aluminum section marker plate
- 17" alder bears N 43° W 44.76 feet; 8" bridge spike, yellow aluminum section marker plate
- 8" alder bears S 12° E 12.77 feet; 8" bridge spike, yellow aluminum section marker plate

Aspect: Gentle west

Centerline of road is 5 feet north, bears N 80° E. Creek, course N 45° W, is 38 feet, S 74° W.
