I found a B.L.M. 2" iron pipe with a 3" brass cap, (see B.L.M. Rewitness in Tillamook County Surveyors Book 6 at Page 111).

History of found monument

I found this monument to be as reported on Tillamook County Surveyors map #B-1025 and its' accessories found and/or set at that time to now be as follows:

(Original B.T.) 40" fir N.67°W. 69 lks, reported in 1978 by Book 6 Page 111 as a fir snag, size indeterminate, N.67°W. 69 lks, no marks visible, and reported on map B-1025 as a 40" fir snag N.67°W. 46.4', no marks visible; (Found, now a 40" fir snag, 10' tall, N.67°W. 46.4' to the center of the snag, no marks visible).

(Original B.T.) 30" fir N.33°E. 41 lks, reported in Book 2 page 260 as a 30" dead fir N.33°E. 41 links marked "1/4S B1", reported in rewitness #708 as visible marks "1/4S" on fallen shell, reported in 1978 by Book 6 at Page 111 as a fir snag, size indeterminate, N.33°E. 41 lks, with scribe marks "1/4" visible on open blaze, and reported on map B-1025 as a 30" fir snag N.31°E. 28.8', no marks visible; (Found, now a 30" fir snag, 25' tall, N.31°E. 28.8' to the center of the snag, no marks visible).

(Book 2 Page 260) 15" fir N.75°E. 12 links, reported in Book 6 Page 111 as a 22" fir N.75°E. 15 lks, reported on map B-1025 as a 22" fir N.75°E. 9.6'; (Found, now a 27" fir N.75°E. 9.53' to a nail with brass T.C.S. washer in a small blaze in the side center of the tree, face overgrown).

(Book 2 Page 260) 16" fir S.69°W. 7 links, reported in Book 6 Page 111 as a 28" fir S.67°W. 6 lks, reported on map B-1025 as 28" fir S.64°W. 4.6'; (Found, now a 33" fir stump, 4' high, S.64°W. 4.45' to a nail with brass T.C.S. washer in a small blaze in the side center of the tree, face overgrown).

New Accessory

20" fir N.6°E. 8.29' to a nail with brass T.C.S. washer in a small blaze in the side center of the tree, overgrown blaze faces SE).

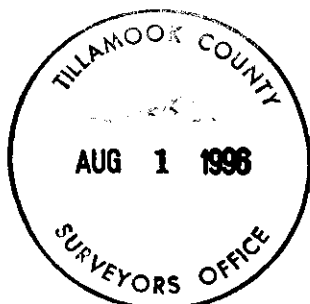
Monument Location

This Monument is located ± 200' Westerly of the power lines road in an East-West cutting line, clear cut to the south, and ± 500' East Highway 22.

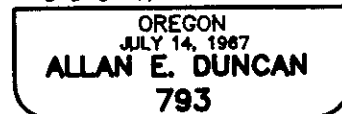
