I FOUND A 2' IRON PIPE WITH A 3' B. L. M. BRASS CAP, (SEE T.C.S. FIELD NOTE BIN S31 1S8 FOR MICROFILM OF THE B.L.M. FIELD NOTES). PIPE AND CAP WERE ON THE WESTERLY EDGE OF A RECENT UPROOT CAUSED HOLE, WHICH EXPOSED THE EASTERLY SIDE OF THE MONUMENT, BUT, IT APPEARED TO BE PLUMB AND UNDISTURBED. I LOWERED THE FOUND IRON PIPE AND BRASS CAP AND ENCASED IT IN AN IRREGULAR MASS OF CONCRETE AND STONES.
