

Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition & Source): Found an Oregon State Board of Forestry 3" diameter bronze cap stamped as shown hereon. I placed 120 pounds of concrete inside a 12" diameter plastic cylinder around the found monument. Found a 39" diameter stump (was a 24" diameter Spruce tree), 3.0' tall with visible scribing on a chopped out face, located at record position, see Map B-530. Found a 31" diameter stump (was a 7" diameter Spruce tree), 3.0' tall with no visible scribing, located at record position, see Map B-530. Found a 4" x 4" wood post with a yellow metal location tag , lying on the ground next to the corner monument

Other new accessories set: Set a 72" Hat Section post with yellow metal location tag North 3.0' from the corner monument.		
New Bearing Trees: *A 7" diameter Hemlock tree scribed "T1SR9WS36BTCS" with a brass washer stamped "TC SURV" and nail set between the 'B & T' which bears South 37° West 9.1'. *A 17" diameter Hemlock tree scribed "T1SR9WS25BTCS" with a brass washer stamped "TC SURV" and nail set between the 'B & T' which bears North 67° West 15.9'. * INDICATES TILLAMOOK COUNTY YELLOW METAL LOCATION POSTER TAG ATTACHED.
