| Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition & Source): Found a 3" diameter Oregon State Board of Forestry cap upright and in good condition. I placed a 12" diameter plastic cylinder and 120 pounds of concrete around the found monument. The cap is stamped as shown hereon. The Center-South 1/16 corner is located South 14° 42' 46" East 48.0 feet (record values Map B-337) from the found reference monument. The position of the 1/16 corner falls in the road, so a monument was never set at the 1/16 corner position. | | | |
| We searched for and found the bearing trees described in Rewitness Book 2, Page 289 set by Louis W. Amort R.E. 2311 in 1953. These trees were set as accessories to the position of the actual Center-South 1/16 corner. We found a 6' tall, 36" diameter Douglas Fir stump at record position with visible scribe marks and a metal location poster tag. Found a very rotten, 4' tall, 60" diameter Douglas Fir stump at record position, with the '2311' scribe marks partially visible. | | | |

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| New accessories set: Set a 72" hat section post 3 feet South of corner monument. | | | |
| New Bearing Trees: 31" diameter Douglas Fir tree scribed "CS 1/16 RM S4 BT" with nail and aluminum washer stamped "TILL.CO.SURVEYOR" set between the 'B&T', which bears North 04° West 12.5'. 12" diameter Douglas Fir tree scribed "CS 1/16 RM S4 BT" with nail and aluminum washer stamped "TILL.CO.SURVEYOR" set between the 'B&T', which bears South 52° East 29.2'. The angle right from the 31" Douglas Fir to the 12" Douglas Fir is 132° 00'00". | | | |
