


Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition & Source): Found a 3" O.S.B.F. Brass Cap with a rock collar, set in Rewitness Book 1, Page 366. The monument is stamped as shown hereon. Tied the monument conventionally using GPS established control. The Oregon North Zone State Plane in NAD 83/91 grid coordinate for the monument is N = 636229.066, E = 7374013.543, US Survey Feet. (G.L.O.) – Found original (14" X 10" X 4" Basalt Stone marked 1/4) in rock collar. (G.L.O.) – Found 20" dia. (was 6" Spruce) rotted Hemlock stump bearing (N 60° E 11 lks. [7.26']) axe work visible. (G.L.O.) – Found 28" dia. (was 7" Spruce) Hemlock stump, 2' tall, bearing (S 62° W 31 lks. [20.46']). (Book 1, Page 366) – Found uproot (was 19" dia. Hemlock) bearing (N 82° E 13.0'). (Book 1, Page 366) – Found (4" X 4" cedar post), burnt badly, with tag, lying next to monument. (Book 1, Page 366) – Found (rock bluff 10' high, 25' long bears S.E. 24'). Monument Set (Procedures and Description): Not applicable.	Sketch of Found Monument: 	
New accessories set: Set a nail with center punch on rock bluff for an occupy point to tie the monument. The Oregon North Zone State Plane in NAD 83/91 grid coordinate is N = 636207.747, E = 7374039.828, U.S. Survey Feet. Set a 5/8" X 40" iron rod with a red plastic cap marked, "Till. Co. Random" on logging road for a backsight point to tie the monument. The Oregon North Zone State Plane in NAD 83/91 grid coordinate is N = 636140.120, E = 7374063.524, U.S. Survey Feet. Set 120 lbs. of concrete in a 12" diameter cylinder around monument. Re-stacked the rock collar. Reset the original stone on the westerly side of monument. Set a 72" hat section post with a yellow metal location tag, North 3.0' from monument.		
New Bearing Trees set: 8" dia. Fir bears N 54° E 7.5', scribed "1/4 S30 BT", with a yellow metal location tag and an aluminum nail with washer marked "Till. Co. Surveyor" on the face. 8" dia. Fir bears S 50° E 14.5', scribed "T2S R8W BT", with a yellow metal location tag and an aluminum nail with washer marked "Till. Co. Surveyor" on the face.		
Location & Comments: Corner is located approx. 100' North of a gravel logging road, approx. 30' N.W. of a rock bluff.
