


The monument is stamped as shown hereon. Found a hat section post with a yellow metal location tag (North 1.5') from monument as set in Rewitness Book 7, Page 66. (G.L.O.) – Did not find the (Hemlock 20 ins. dia. bears N 52° E 54 lks. [35.64']). (G.L.O.) – Found rotten remains of a (Y. Fir 56 ins. dia. bears N 55° W 21 lks. [13.86']). (G.L.O.) – Did not find the (Hemlock 4 ins. dia. bears S 53 1/2° W 56 lks. [36.96']). (G.L.O.) – Found 72" Yellow Fir Stump, 7' tall, with nail, (bears S 42° E 60 lks. [39.6']). (Book 6, Page 6) – Found 38" Fir Stump, (was 30"), 3' tall, (bears N 42° E 18.5'), scribing visible. (Book 6, Page 6) – Found 24" Fir Stump, 5' tall, (bears S 31° E 36.9'), healed over face and yellow metal location tag affixed. (Book 6, Page 6) – Found 16" Fir Stump badly rotten, (was 12"), 3' tall, (bears N 71° W 17.7'), healed over face. (Book 6, Page 6) – Found 30" Fir Stump rotten, 5' tall, (bears S 4° W 24.7'), scribing visible and a "Do Not Cut" tag affixed. [] Indicates converted value from links to feet. New accessories set: Set 120 lbs. of concrete in a 12" dia. cylinder around the monument.			
New Bearing Trees set: * 9" dia. D. Fir bears N 72° E 26.6', scribed "T2SR9WS19BT", tagged and painted. * 9" dia. D. Fir bears S 57° E 27.0', scribed "T2SR9WS30BT", tagged and painted. * 10" dia. D. Fir bears S 21° W 21.4', scribed "T2SR10WS25BT", tagged and painted. * 9" dia. D. Fir bears N 38° W 24.4', scribed "T2SR10WS24BT", tagged and painted. * Indicates an aluminum nail with a washer marked "Till. Co. Surveyor" was set in the face between the scribed "B" and "T" and a yellow metal location tag was affixed.			
Location & Comments: Monument is located approximately 100' NW of a logging road in a small flat area and approximately 80' SW of the toe of a steep slope.
