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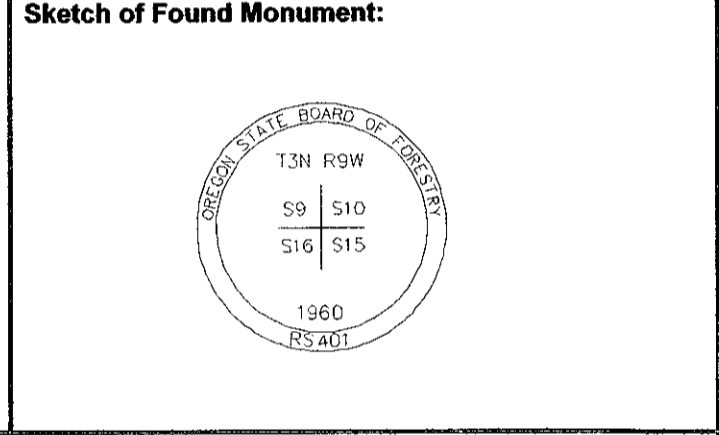

Found Monument(s) and Accessories (Condition & Source): Found a 3" diameter O.S.B.F. Brass Cap in a grown over uproot, leaning and out of position. Corner was restored in Book 1, Page 419 (1960). Monument is stamped as shown hereon.
 (G.L.O.) – Did not find the (10" Hemlock bears N 28 1/2° E 60 lks. [39.60']).
 (G.L.O.) – Did not find the (20" Hemlock bears S 30° E 50 lks. [33.00']).
 (G.L.O.) – Did not find the (8" Hemlock bears S 43° W 90 lks. [59.40']).
 (G.L.O.) – Found 70" Cedar Stump, (bears N 36° W 31 lks. [20.46']), face rotted away, axe marks visible.
 (Book 1, Page 419) – Found 26" Hemlock, (was 16"), (bears S 68° W 17.7'), face visible and yellow metal location tag.
 (Book 1, Page 419) – Found 18" Hemlock Snag, 30' tall, (bears N 60 1/2° W 56.0'), scribing visible.
 (Book 1, Page 419) – Found Hemlock uproot, (was 26" Hemlock bears S 83° E 23.7').
 (Book 1, Page 419) – Found Hemlock uproot, (was 26" Hemlock bears N 35° E 51.0').

Monument Re-Set (Procedures and Description):
 After sawing out the stump and removing the monument from the root system, we reset the monument using the record distance/distance intersection from the found Hemlock Snag at 56.0' and the found Hemlock at 17.7'. The angle structure still hits record bearings as well.



New Accessories set: Set 120 lbs. of concrete in a 12" dia. cylinder around monument. Set 72" hat section post 3.3' North of the monument. Re-set carsonite post 3.0' East of the monument.

New Bearing Trees Marked:
 * 15" Hemlock bears N 53° W 48.1', scribed "T3N R9W S9 BT", tagged and painted.
 * 30" Hemlock bears N 28° E 31.5', scribed "T3N R9W S10 BT", tagged and painted.
 * 37" Fir bears S 8°30' E 60.6', scribed "T3N R9W S15 BT", tagged and painted.
 * Indicates an aluminum nail with a washer stamped "Till. Co. Surveyor" is set in the face between the scribed "B" and "T".

Location & Comments: Monument is located approx. 200' Easterly of a gravel logging road.
