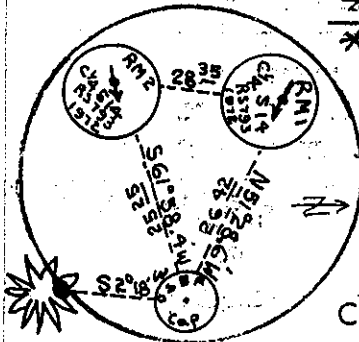

NEW ACCESSORY: USED C 1/4 to CE 1/16 as Meridian = Refer to forestry Maps  
 Foresight = RME F = RMI  
 occupy = C 1/4 49° 28.5' O = C 1/4 216° 01.5'  
 Backsight = CE 1/16 B = CE 1/16

COMMENTS: Found 2" Iron Pipe ± 2" beneath ground level. Dug down ± 3 feet and found another Iron Pipe which was the O.S.B.F. Bronze Cap. While occupying the C 1/4, I Backsighted the CE 1/16 and turned a Horizon Right 7 of 89° 48' to the B.T. @ S2° 18' W 301 5.
