Fair	Hemlock stump with scribe mks "10" visible, on open face bears S 45° E 6 1/2 ft. (GLO)
Badly rotted	Hem. stump bears N 50° E 22 1/4 ft. (GLO)
very very badly rotted	stump bears N 65° W 3 3/4 ft. (GLO)

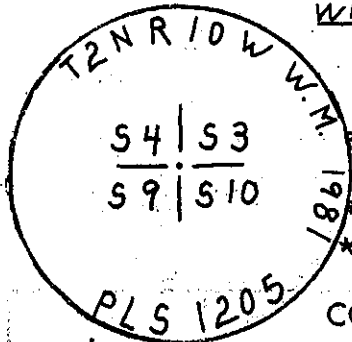

I SET A 10" Alum. form around Colin's I.P. + B.C. and filled it with CONCRETE.

- \* 10" Hem. "S-3 B.T." bears N 83° E 40 1/4 ft to face (A-4402)
- \* 30" Hem. face healed over, N 42° W 71 1/4 ft to tree (B-380)
- \* 30" Hem. " " " S 23° E 64 ft to tree (B-380)
- \* 32" Hem. " " " S 78° W 70 ft to tree (B-380)

COMMENTS: I found Colin's I.P. + B.C., put form and concrete around it, and tied the Existing BTs.

The corner lies approx 600 ft West of road #9700, in N-S cutting line.
