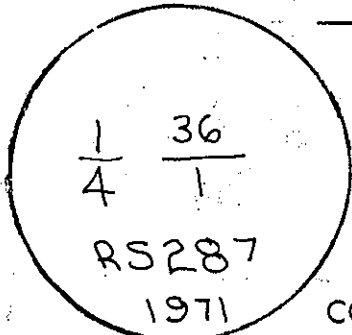

Transit and Tape survey by R.S. #287 (John Louis Carlisch) from Section corner <sup>35136 IN 10</sup> ~~2111310~~ to the 1/4 corner <sup>36 IN 10</sup> ~~1310~~ showed the bearing and distance to be N89°50'51"E and 2643<sup>84</sup> feet to the section corner. Survey made by: U.G. JACKSON - found on map F-9-11 (1912) - showed the corner at N89°52'E and 2642<sup>2</sup> feet.

COMMENTS: Limb was accepted as being the 1/4 corner set by U.G. JACKSON in 1912.
