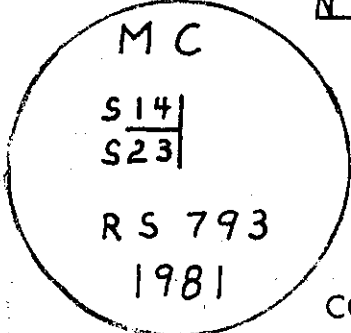

Found	Rotted Spruce stump with scribe marks "MC" visible on N.E. face, ± 8" from center of the stump. (G.L.O. Spruce 16" dia. S 65° W 9 Lks)
Found	An Alder tree and a Spruce tree growing out of the remains of a spruce stump (G.L.O. Corner tree, 30" Dia Spruce)
Gone	(G.L.O. bearberry 4" Dia. N 25° W 17 Lks)

1 SET A 1 1/2" x 30" IRON PIPE with BRASS CAP in CONCRETE at N 65° E 9 Lks (5.94 ft) from found G.L.O. B.T.  
 \* 60" Hat Section 2 1/2 EAST



NEW ACCESSORY:
* 10" Dia. Spruce Bears N 61° W 49 1/2 ft to face
Scribed "MC S 14 BT CS" on double face.

COMMENTS: Corner lies on the west bank of Hall Slough. The monument is set between two stumps. An alder SE 2 ft and a spruce NW 2 ft.
