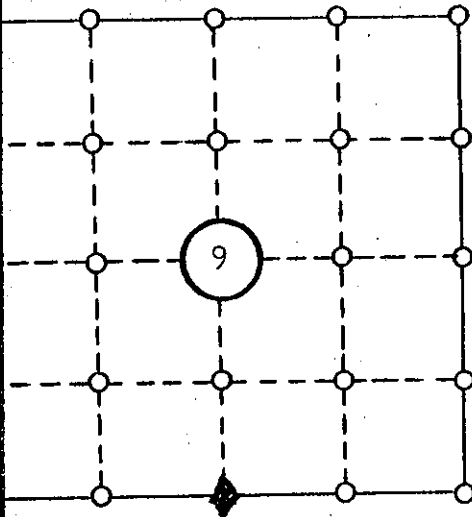

Set basalt stone 18"x15"x7", 12" in the ground  
for 1/4 sec. cor. mkd. "1/4" on N. face, from which:  
A Hemlock 18" dia. N3 W 41lks.  
Mkd. "1/4 SBT"  
A Hemlock 40" dia. S10 E 8lks.  
mkd. "1/4 SBT"

MONUMENT/ACCESSORY*	LOCATION FROM CORNER	WITNESSES	DATE
At the 1/4 corner between sections 9 & 16, T2N, R7W I find a blazed tree conforming in age, size, and direction of blaze with the original notes. The marks have been chopped away. From it I set a point S3 E 27feet. This point falls in the old blazed line and the calls east and west check the original notes. I place a 3" square post 4' long in a mound of stone for the corner.
