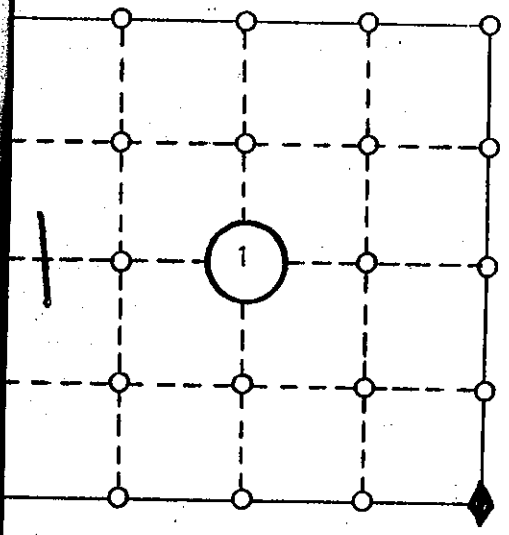

| At the southeast corner of Sec. 1, T2N, R7W, I find a post in a mound of stones. I find the scribed stumps of two fir BT's and the Hemlock recently dead and down. I can not identify the original stone. | | Bert Mason Jr. | Oct. 1956 |
| I found two original BT's and the mound of stones with the post rotted and fallen over and laying next to the stone mound. The two found BT's bear as follows from the mound of stone: 18" Hem., with scribing "T2NR7WS1BT" plainly visible 36" Fir, now a stump cut below face with metal location poster affixed I painted both stumps with orange paint and flagged with fluorescent pink ribbon | N20 W 40ft. (now a very rotten stump) N22 E 22ft. | G.A. Crites D.M. Fitch | 9/8/80 |
