### **Vegetation Management Program**

TILLAMOOK, Ore.—Tillamook County has an active Vegetation Management Program. The Road department performs regular year around maintenance of roadside vegetation that includes routine cutting and disposing of trees, brush, berry, shrubs and other vines that may become a traffic hazard. Maintenance also provides for sight distance safety, drainage, and to prevent further damages to road surfaces and shoulders thereby protecting the publics investment in the county road system. Vegetation Management is vital to extending the life of a road and for public safety.

The Road Department will be implementing the annual road right of way herbicide application beginning the middle of April 2011, given proper weather conditions. This will continue until mid-September, also subject to weather conditions.

Tillamook County does not treat any areas where the property owner agrees to maintain the vegetation to the satisfaction of the Public Works Department. “No spray” signs are available at the Public Works Department for a fee and must be displayed so that the vegetation management crew can easily see them from the roadway. These signs and agreements are available at the Public Works Office at 503 Marolf Loop Road, Tillamook.
