Subject: **Long Prairie Road Road Closure notice from July 6 – 17, 2015**

Tillamook County Public Works will be reconstructing Long Prairie Road from Blimp Blvd to just south of Chance Road as a result of the poor road conditions on Long Prairie Road. This will require closing Long Prairie Road from Blimp Blvd to just south of Chance Road. Access to the Port Industrial area will be open from Hwy 101, expect up to 20 minute delays.

Local access to Baumgartner Road and all of the residences and businesses on Long Prairie in the work zone will be allowed, however you should expect up to 20 minute delays. Other traffic will be detoured around the work zone.

The County will be grinding up the road and performing cement treated base (CTB) with 5 inches of asphalt on top. If you drive your vehicle through the work zone while we are performing CTB, you may want to rinse your vehicle to make sure you rinse the cement off your vehicle.

There will be traffic pattern changes during the project, especially when we rebuild the intersection of Blimp Blvd and Long Prairie. Access to the Port Industrial area will be open; expect 20 minute delays. We will have detour signs in place.

We will be updating the public on the progress of our project, which is weather dependent. If you have any questions, please call me.
