
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, OREGON.

Timber in this area consists of alder, cedar, and spruce.

This plat represents a retracement and reestablishment of a portion of the subdivisional lines designed to restore the corners in their true original location according to the best available evidence; and, excepting as new or modified vacant subdivisions are shown hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved January 8, 1884.

The south and west boundaries and the subdivisional lines were surveyed by Henry Meldrum in 1883, who resurveyed the west boundary in 1884. The south boundaries of sections 31 and 34, a portion of the west boundary of section 31, and the line between sections 33 and 34, were resurveyed by Joseph S. Gawron in 1956-1958.

This dependent resurvey was executed by Lynn M. Roseberry, beginning June 26, 1961 and completed August 11, 1961, pursuant to special instructions for Group No. 450, Oregon, dated June 22, 1961.
