


Vicinity map traced from U.S. Engr

PROPOSED DREDGING

In Nehalem River at mouth of North Fork Nehalem River Tillamook County, Oreg.
It is proposed to build a dike around the island using gravel from the Dredging Area No. 1, and fill inside with mud from Area No. 2, all to above flood level or about Elev 13. Datum is mean low water. Estimated Volume (Fig. 5) 31,000 cu.yd.
