

The history of surveys is contained in the field

This plat represents a dependent resurvey of a portion of the west boundary and subdivisional lines, T. 3 S., R. 8 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon, designed to restore the corners in their true original locations according to the best available evidence, and the subdivision of section 19.

Except as shown hereon, the lottings and areas are as shown on the plat approved December 31, 1884.

The survey was executed by Frank A. Tuers and Ronald E. Paisley, Cadastral Surveyors, beginning March 11, 1985, and completed April 22, 1985, pursuant to Special Instructions dated January 24, 1985, under Group Number 1247, Oregon.

Timber in this area consists of fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, and maple.
