COR. on other 2 39×33·1> YIL COR. 4-3.N.G. faces in black. The corner to sections 32-33-5-4, where we found 3 dead 52/50.1 bearing trees, scribed, from which we set a 2" x 48" galv. iron SEC. Thence we ran Westerly by traverse to the quarter corner between sections 32 and 5, where we found a 20" hemlock snag scribed for the original quarter corner and 2 dead bearing trees. The quarter corner is 2633.2 ft. S89°  $40\frac{1}{2}$ °W. of the section corner At a point 3.0 ft. EAST of the true corner we set a 2" x 48" galv. 14 COR. N. BOK Y . iron pipe for a witness corner, with brass cap on which is stamped 5-3N.6. a line with short cross mark and the numbers 32 and 5 and, circumferentially, 1/4 COR. W.C. TPS. 3&4 N.R.6W.W.M. - O.S.H.D. We also set a 4" x 4" white guard post steneiled 1/4 SEC. COR. on 2 faces in black. No live trees available for bearing trees. We returned to the corner to sections 35-36-2-1 on the line between Twps. 3 and 4 N., R. 6 W., and ran thence Southerly by traverse to the quarter corner between sections 2 and 1 and to the corner to sections 2-1-11-12. Returning again to the corner to sections 35-36-2-1, we ran, S. 1°  $04\frac{1}{2}$ . E. on a true line between sections 2 and 1. 20+76.1 The quarter corner between sections 2 and 1. We found stumps of both bearing trees with portions of the blaze remaining. 14 COR. We set a 2" x 48" galv. iron pipe with brass cap on which is 1,2-3,N.6 stamped a line with short cross mark and the numbers 2 and 1 and, W.BBRy & 1 circumferentially, 1/4 COR. T. 3 N. R. 6 W. W. M. - O.S.H.D. We also set a 4" x 4" white guard post stenciled 1/4 SEC. COR. on 2 faces and O.S.H. PROP. COR. on other 2 faces in black. No live trees available for bearing trees. Thence we ran S 0° 28' E. continuing on a true line between sections 2 and 1. 22+74.9 Centerline of the Wolf Creek highway at Sta. 1284+30.1 P.O.T. We set a 3/4" x 30" iron pin for the South 1/16 corner on 33+99.6 /16 COR 1,2-3,11,6 the line between sections 2 and 1, with a 4" x 4" white guard post S, on W. BORY stenciled 1/16 SEC. We also set a 4" x 4" white guard post stenciled 3.1, 11, 12 EM & I. SEC. COR. on 2 faces in black. No live trees available for bearing trees. BOOK I
