47" Fir stump bears N55°E 21.1 ft.; scribed 1/4 S14 BT RS 82.

67" Cedar stump bears S190W 50.2 ft.; scribed 1/4 S23 BT.

3" x 4" x 72" white Cedar post 1 ft. SW of pipe.
