## RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Sections 5 and 8, Township 2 North, Range 8 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

## ORIGINAL

Stone  $16^n \times 10^n \times 7^n$  out of place, marks now weathered and uncertain from which a:

40 Fir bears N50 W 19 lks.; now missing, roots in place.

24th Hemlock bears S20 W 18 lks.; now 20th stub 30 ft. high, BT scribes visible.

## RESTORED

Set 1½th x 36th galvanized iron pipe with 3th bronze cap marked thoregon STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4, the 35 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which as

60° Fir stump bears S65°E 28.2 ft.; scribed 1/4 S8 BT RE 2311.
40° Fir stump bears N1°W 32.6 ft.; scribed 1/4 S5 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 60% Fir stump BT.

4% x 4% x 72% white Cedar post 1.5 ft. SW of pipe.

also posted on original 24% Hemlock BT.
