12"x7"x6" stone, now in place with 5 notches on S and 3 on E sides, from which a:

- 18" Hemlock-bears N53°E 29-lks.; now 30" stub 3 ft. high, badly rotted.
  - 5" Hemlock bears Sll°E 55 lks.; now missing, point falls in slide area.
- 12" Hemlock bears S77°W 26 lks.; now just roots remaining in place.
- 14" Hemlock bears N27°W 79 lks.; now 11" stub 4 ft. high, badly rotted.

Erected mound of rock around original stone, from which a:

- 70" Cedar stump bears 'S7°W 24.8 ft.; scribed T2N R8W S16 BT.
- -63" Fir snag bears Sl2°E 104.3 ft.; scribed T2N R8W Sl5 BT RE 2311.
  - 4" Alder bears N23°W 34.8 ft.; scribed X BT.
- 4" Alder bears N15°E 54.3 ft.; scribed X BT.
