AFFIDADIT

I. Barold S. Williams, under oath state as follows:--

1) I have been a professional tiles cruisor all my vorking life. As such, it has been my business to find, followed identify Coverment survey lines and corners.

2) As to the corners comen to Sections 25 and 36 of TEN, RIOW, w.M., — in connection with my work in cruising timber and runking subdivision lines in these sections, I have been to those corners many times, from about 1978 to 1951. I have or several occasions fo loved the blazed section line from the SW corner of Section 25 to the quarter corner common to Sections 25 and 36. At this time, that is, beginning in 1918, what were apparently the original Government blazes on this line were plain and early followed; from time to time I removed and added additional blazes; at one time, about 1920, at the point where the line crosses the Mani-Feley County Road, I marked an "X" blaze facing the road, on the tree nearest the line, which was a young spruce on the mest side of the road. This "X" mark was to me a familiar mark in the vicinity, until about 1950 the tree has cut, and the body carrying the "X" mark was dragged southward and eastward, series the road, here it remains and can be seen to this date, and the stump of the spruce, marking the point near to where the section line crosses the road, remains in its position. This blazed section line was very nearly true East and West by compass.

The GLO lotes describe it corner as a stake, located 355 links or 254 foot west from a creek lo links with bearing trees, a Homlock 14" S 40*E 8 links, and a Hemlock 5". H 65*E 11 links. Athin my monory, the Bearing Tree to the south had disappered, the BT to the north only remaining, but it was in good condition, with the scribe makes plaints be seen. Thepesition was very close to the 234 feet called for west of the creek. There was a small spruce a few feet south from the corner, on which had been axed off a flattened face where various cruisers wrete their names and dated with crayon.

The SE corner of section 25 was a stale, sitnessed by 4 small Vine Maples. The bearing of the East half mile of this section line, from the a corner to the SE corner, was several degrees North of Best. Much of the lite ran thru open or brushy country, and it nover was blazed very vell, or easy to follow. Athin my memory, one of the Vine Maple Bearing trees, with scribe marks shoring, remained. It was located in a brushy scale or draw, with no good trees for permanent Bearing Trees close by. Unfortuneately, no permanent marker was put in at this corner, and apparently it is lost.

then I last visited the location of this quarter Corner to 25 and 36, the corner state and Bearing Tree had been destroyed by the building of a truck read. But the line of blozes from the west, including the stump of the tree on which I made the "X" mark, at the read crossing, remain; a line of blozes which I made, South from the corner that the read crossing the small blozed spruce, which stood South from the corner stake, remains, on the south edge of the read cut. It is my true and honest belief, from my knowledge of this corner as it existed up to the time that the truck read was built, that a point in the bed of the truck read, which point is 12 feet north from the mentioned blozed spruce, and is now marked by a truck and shaft and now bearing trees, is within feet of the true original position of the quarter Corner.
