Restored Corner for Oregon State Board of Forestry

One quarter corner common to Sections 17 and 18, T3N, R6W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

## ORIGINAL

Stake, now missing, from which a:

24" Hemlock bears N54°15'E 42 lks.; now 28" snag, edges of burnt out original face remaining.
36" Fir bears N71°W 23½ lks.; now 40" stump, scribes BT

remaining.

## RESTORED

Set  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY  $\frac{1}{4}$  S17 S18 1955 RE2311," 32 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

7" Fir bears S5°W 3.2 ft.; scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$  S18 BT RE2311. 6" Hemlock bears S23 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E 18.7 ft.; scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$  S17 BT.

Set 4"x3"x72" white painted Cedar post 2 ft. NW of pipe.
