24" Hemlock bears \$49°E 41 lks.; now 26" uproot, downhill out of place; original axe marks visible.

60" Fir bears N40E 53 lks.; now 47" stump, scribes 4 S BT visible.

RESTORED

Set $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY $\frac{1}{4}$ S8 S17 1955 RE2311," 32 inches in ground, in small mound of stone, and from which a:

8" Fir bears N57 $\frac{1}{8}$ °E 29.2 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S8 BT RE2311. 7" Fir bears S82°E 48.5 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S17 BT.

Set 3"x3"x72" white painted Cedar post 1.5 ft. NE of pipe. Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 8" Fir BT
