RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to Section 24 (East side) T3N, R7W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

12" Hemlock bears N46°W 7 lks.; roots and root hole in place. 36" Fir bears \$72°E 20 lks.; now 28" snag, scribes 1/4 remaining.

## RESTORED

Set  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY  $\frac{1}{4}$  S24 1955 RE 2311," 33 inches in ground, and from which a:

24" Fir snag bears \$380W 36.1 ft.; scribed  $\frac{1}{4}$  \$24 BT RE2311.

Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted Cedar post 1.5 ft. NE of pipe. Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 24" Fir snag BT.
