16" Hemlock bears \$68°W 48 lks.; now 18" uproot, original

axe marks remaining, roots in place.
60" Fir bears N79°W 65 lks.; now 55" stump, portion of scribe on upper face and BT remaining on lower face.

> 34" Fir stump bears S34°W 103.2 ft.; scribed T3N R7W \$25 BT.

> 11" Noble Fir bears N63°W 149.4 ft.; scribed T3N R7W S24 BT RE2311.

Set  $4" \times 4" \times 72"$  white painted Cedar post 1.5 ft. NW of pipe. Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 11" Fir N1920E 95.0 ft. (on North edge road).
