- 16" Spruce bears S45°W 44 lks.; now 36" stub 10° high, scribes T2N R9W S visible, rest unexposed.

  - 18" Alder bears S74°E 43.8 ft.; scribed T2N R9W S17 BT (bark scribed)
  - 12" Fir bears N252°E 121.7 ft.; scribed T2N R9W S8 BT.
