8" Fir bears S57W 53.3 ft.; scribed T3N R8W S9 BT. 24" Hemlock bears S88E 125.9 ft.; scribed T3N R8W S10 BT RS401.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 8" Fir BT. Set 4" x 4" x 66" white painted Cedar post 1.0' S.E. of pipe. Also poster on 10" Fir B.T. uproot.
