**CHAINS** 

RECOVERY AND RESTORATION of the NC 1/16 corner of Section 27, T 1 N, R 10 W, W.M.

On October 11, 1960, I ran South out of the  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Sections 22 and 27, T 1 N, R 10 W, W.M. (Restored by O.S.B.F. July 9, 159) 1303.8 feet and found:

I chopped into this and exposed 50 yr. Old BT 43" Hemlock. old scribing "/165".

I chopped into this and exposed old Old BT 28" Hemlock. scribing "BT".

In the presence of: George L. Hieber

Returned to area on December 7, 1960, with copy of County Surveyors Notes, dated January, 1923, calling for:

BT 43" Hemlock N o 11.5 feet distant BT 28" Hemlock N 880 E 21.0 feet distant

I set Hemlock post 11.5 feet distant N  $1^{\circ}$  W (var.  $23^{\circ}$  E) and 21.0 feet distant N  $81^{\circ}$  E to the respective BT's.

In the presence of: Robert T. Reed

Returned to area July 17, 1962, and set a 1" galvanized irop pipe with a lead plug, 6" out of the ground, in place of the Hemlock post. I then reset the Hemlock post 1.0 feet West of the iron pipe.

The top of the lead plug is marked as follows:
