A hemlock stump, 33 inches in diam., bears N 79° E, a distance of 16.5 feet (25 lks.), scribe marks: 4 S B exposed.

At the corner point:

Set a la inch iron pipe, 3 feet long, with an Oregon State Board of Forestry bronze cap stamped: 4 S17 S20 1951 199.
