RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Corner common to sections 8, 9, 16 and 17, T. 2 S., R. 7 W., W. M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post; now missing, from which a:

12" Hemlock bears S72 W 36 lks; now missing.

30" Hemlock bears N55W 21 1ks; now 35" snag, face burnt out.

12" Hemlock bears N2OE 41 1ks; now down 12" stub out of place and badly burnt.

20" Hemlock bears S80E 29 lks; now down 20" stub shoved out of place by logging, scribe marks T2S R7W S exposed.

RESTORED CORNER AND BEARING TREES

Set a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T2S R7W S8 S9 S17 S16 1951 2311", $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. in ground. Raised mound of stone around pipe from which a:

60" Fir stump bears S19W 6.9 ft; scribed T2S R7W S17 2311 ET.

38" Hemlock snag bears N2OE 39.0 ft; scribed T2S R7W S9 BT.

60" Fir stump bears S33E 42.0 ft; scribed T2S R7W S16 BT.

60" Fir stump bears N222W 39.8 ft; scribed T2S R7W S8 BT.

Placed an Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 35" Hemlock snag BT and marked it: Sec 8 T2S R7W Sec Cor 14 ft. S55E.
