ORIGINAL.

Post, now missing from which a:

17" Hemlock bears S55W 30 lks; now roots remaining. 11" Hemlock bears N12E 59 1ks; now down 13" stub with roots in place, exposed scribe marks BT.

RESTORED CORNER AND BEARING TREES

Set a lan x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T2S R7W S12 S13 1/4 S 1951 2311" $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. in ground. Raised mound of stone around pipe from which a:

66" Fir stump bears S27 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 23.7 ft.; scribed 1/4 S13 2311 BT. 30" Fir stub, 12 ft. high, bears N39W 54.6 ft.; scribed 1/4 S12 BT.

Placed a metal location poster on 66" fir stump BT and marked it: Sec 13 T2S R7W Sec Cor 25.2 ft. N29E.
