ORIGINAL

Post; now missing, from which a:

40" Hemlock bears East 35 lks; now 40" down stub roots in place; scribe marks 1/4 BT exposed.
24" Hemlock bears S85W 18 lks; now a 24" stump; face rotted off felled log from this stump.

RESTORED CORNER AND BEARING TREES

Set $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S30 S29 1952 2311", $2\frac{1}{2}$ " in ground, from which a:

48" Fir stump bears S63W 9.3°; scribed 1/4 S30 BT 2311. 66" Fir stump bears S75F 46.0°; scribed 1/4 S29 BT 2311.

Placed an Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 48" fir stump BT and marked it: Sec 30 TIS R7W 1/4 Cor 9.3 Ft. N63E.
