Corner common to sections 25, 30, 31, and 36, Township 3 North, Ranges 7 & 8 West, W.M., Tillemook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL.

24" x 18" x 6" basalt stone, now 16" x 12" x 6" stone marked with five notches on north face, from which a:

16" Hemlock bears N2OE 41 lks; now 18" root stub.

10" Hemlock bears S44E 32 lks; now missing.

14" Hemlock bears S77W 37 lks; now 16" root stub.

15" Hemlock bears N41W 25 lks; now missing.

RESTORED CORNER AND BEARING TREES

Set 1^{1}_{2} " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T3N R8W R7W S25 S30 S36 S31 1952 2311, " 22 in ground. Placed corner stone on north side of pipe and raised mound of stone around corner pipe, from which a:

60" Fir stump bears S89E 30.6"; scribed T3N R7W S31 BT.

50" Fir stump bears NO6E 15.6"; scribed T3N R7W S30 BT.

36" Fir stub bears N80W 22.5"; scribed T3N R8W S25 BT 2311

36" Fir stub bears SO8W 15.5"; scribed T3N R8W S36 BT.

Placed an Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 60" Fir snag BT and marked it: Sec 31 T3N R7W Sec Cor 30.6 Ft. N89W.
