Post, now missing, from which a:

- 12" Hemlock bears N17°30'E 42 lks; now 22" stub 10' high, part of scribe mark visible on edge of burnt out face.
- 7" Yew bears S34°30° E 77 lks; now 10" down snag. 30" Hemlock bears S65°30° W 16 lks; now 34" snag, part of scribe mark visible on edge of burnt out face.
 - 8" Hemlock bears N24°30'W 13 lks; now missing. (Distances measured from center of trees)

RESTORED CORNER AND BEARING TREES

Set 1^{1}_{8} " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY TIS ROW S21 S22 S28 S27 1952 2311, 22 in ground. Raised mound of stone around corner pipe, from which a:

36" Fir stump bears S22W 10.8"; scribed S28 BT.

34" Fir snag bears N41W 6.4°; scribed T1S R6W S21 BT RE 2311. 53" Fir stump bears S48°30°E 61.4°; scribed T1S R6W S27 BT. 53" Fir stump bears N41°30°E 46.3°; scribed T1S R6W S22 BT.

Placed an Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 34" Fir snag BT and marked it: Sec 21 TlS R6W Sec Cor 6.4 Ft. S4LE.
