- parts of scribes visible on both faces. 8" Hemlock bears S22030'W 92 lks; now 20" down snag, scribe marks T, S, & 4 on fragments alongside.
- 8" Hemlock bears N30W 47 lks; now 14" down stub out of place, part of scribe mark visible.

RESTORED CORNER AND BEARING TREES

Set $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY TIN R8W S33 S3 S4 T1S CC 1952 2311," $2\frac{1}{2}$ " in ground. Raised mound of stone around corner pipe, from which a:

72" Fir stump bears N60W 15.2'; scribed TlN R8W CC S3 S4 BT.

5" Fir bears S29°30'W 144.0"; scribed TIS R8W S4 BT.

5" Fir bears S64E 116.0"; scribed S3 BT RE 2311.

Placed an Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 72" Fir stump BT and marked it: Sec 33 TlN R8W CC 3 & 4 Cor 15.2' S60E.

Dated April 30, 1952.
