As a reference monument

Set 12" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY RM T2S R7W S33 S34 S4 S3 T3S Cor. 23 Ft. W 1952 2311," 22" in ground, 23.0" East of corner point. Raised mound of stone around pipe.

42" Fir stub bears SO9°30'E 101.0' from the corner point; scribed T3S R7W S3 BT.

20" Fir snag bears N17030'W 35.3' from the corner point; scribed T2S R7W S33 BT RE 2311.

14" Fir stub 20' high bears S84W 10.4' from the corner point; scribed T3S R7W S4 BT.

Placed an Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 14" Fir stub BT and marked it: Sec 4 T3S R7W Sec Cor 10.4 Ft. N84E.
