RESTORED CORNER

Set 12" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S18 S17 1952 2311," $2\frac{1}{2}$ " in ground. Raised mound of stone around corner pipe.

Placed an Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on Original BT now 20" Fir and marked it: Sec 17 T2N R9W 1/4 Cor4-8Ft. N87W.
