RESTORED CORNER AND BEARING TREES

Set 12" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY TIS R7W S35 S36 S2 S1 T2S 1952 2511, 21 in ground. Raised mound of stone around corner pipe, from which a:

50" Fir snag bears S74E 23.0"; scribed T2S R7W SL BT. 38" Fir snag bears N65W 40.8"; scribed TIS R7W S35 BT RE

50" Fir stump bears S79°30'W 4.8"; scribed T2S R7W S2 BT. Nothing available in NE quadrant.

Placed an Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 50" Fir snag BT and marked it: Sec 1 T2S R7W Sec Cor 23.0 Ft. N74W.
