RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

One quarter corner common to sections 9 and 10, Township 2 North, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

16" x 10" x 8" basalt stone, now in place marked 1/4, from which a:

30" Hemlock bears S53W 62 lks; now 54" snag, scribe marks 1/4 S exposed.

32" Hemlock bears N76E 29 lks; now 50" snag, scribe marks 1/4 S exposed.

RESTORED CORNER

Set 12 x 36 galvanized iron pipe with 3 bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S9 S10 1952 2311," 22 in ground. Placed 1/4 stone on north edge of pipe.

Placed an Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 50° Hemlock snag BT and marked it: Sec 10 T2N R7W 1/4 Cor 19.4 Ft. S78° 30° W.

Dated June 7, 1952.
