## RESTORED CORNER FOR OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY

Section corner common to sections 5, 6, 31, and 32, Townships 2 and 3 North, Range 8 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

### ORIGINAL

16" x 8" x 6" basalt stone, now missing, from which a:

36" Fir bears N82E 21 lks.; now 44" snag, scribe marks 3 N R8W S32 exposed. Did not attempt to expose scribe marks BT.

30" Hemlock bears S25E 36 lks.; now missing. 15" Hemlock bears S22W 51 lks.; now missing. 18" Hemlock bears N72W 40 lks.; now missing.

### RESTORED CORNER AND WITNESSED CORNER POINT

Set  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked \*OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY T3N R8W S31 S32 S6 S5 T2N 1953 2311," 22 in ground. Raised mound of stone around corner pipe, from which a:

> 52" Fir snag bears N41°30°W 53.8°; scribed T3N R8W S31 BT. 50" Fir snag bears S42°30°W 9.3°; scribed T2N R8W S6 BT RE 2311.

36" Fir snag bears SO7°30'E 31.0'; scribed T2N R8W S5 BT.


