Section corner common to Sections 10, 11, 14 and 15, Township 1 North, Range 7 West, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

ORIGINAL

Post, now missing, from which a:

- 23" Hemlock bears N37W 44 lks.; now 30" down stub, (uprooted) face rotted and burned out.
- 28" Hemlock bears-N45E 34 lks.; now 35" 20 ft. high stub, face and scribes burned and rotted off.
- 13" Hemlock bears S48E 40 lks.; now 20" stump 6" high, 10 ft. section downhill with BT scribes.
- 9" Hemlock bears S21W 48 lks.; now 8", down, and out of place, BT scribes.

RESTORED

Set 12" x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked **OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY TIN R7W SIO SII SI4 SI5 1953 2311, 30 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

36" Fir snag bears N21°30'W 64.4 ft.; scribed TlN R7W S10 BT RE 2311.

72" Fir stump bears N34E 49.6 ft.; scribed TlN R7W Sll BT. 43" Fir stump bears S63W 52.8 ft.; scribed TlN R7W S15 BT. 28" Fir stump bears S12E 41.9 ft.; scribed TlN R7W S14 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 28" Fir stump BT.

Set 4" x 4" x 48" white cedar post 2 ft. north of pipe. Set 4" x 4" x 48" white cedar post 468 ft. north and 18 ft. west of corner, on SW shoulder of road.
