now 40" snag, scribes \(\frac{1}{4} \) S BT visible.

56" Fir stump bears S36E 35.6 ft.; scribed \(\frac{1}{4}\) S4 BT.

84" Fir stump bears S14W 63.6 ft.; scribed \(\frac{1}{4}\) S5 BT.
