now 14" stub 12 ft. high, bears N13E,
BT scribes visible.

10" Hemlock bears N63W 12 lks.;
now 11" stub 7 ft. high bears N52W

10" Hemlock bears N63W 12 1ks.; now 11" stub 7 ft. high, bears N53W, top of old face showing, no scribes remaining.

Set  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY  $\frac{1}{4}$  S5 S6 1953 2311,"
30 inches in ground, in mound of stone, and from which a:

16" Fir snag bears S85W 29.5 ft.; scribed \$\frac{1}{4}\$ S 6 BT.
42" Fir snag bears N71E 58.2 ft.; scribed \$\frac{1}{4}\$ S 5 BT RE 2311.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 42" Fir snag BT.

4" x 4" x 48" white Cedar post 1 ft. north of pipe.
