10" Fir bears S3°W 16 lks.; now 17" snag, scribes BT visible, rest unexposed. 5" Hemlock bears N45°E 9 lks.; now 28", scribes

1/4 S visible, rest unexposed.

RESTORED

Var. 2120E

Set land x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 4 S35 S36 1955 RE 2311," 33 inches in ground, in small mound of stone, and from which a:

32" Spruce bears S88°W 29.9 ft.; scribed $\frac{1}{4}$ S35 BT RE 2311.

Set 4"x4"x96" white painted Cedar post 2.5 ft. NW of pipe. Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 32" Spruce BT.

Also poster on 4"x4"x72" white painted Cedar post 635.8 ft. S. on N. edge Miami River Highway.
