Set $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" galvanized iron pipe with 3" bronze cap marked "OREGON STATE BOARD OF FORESTRY 1/4 S5 S4 1956 RE 2311," 33 inches in ground, with old pipe inside, and from which a:

10" Fir bears S61°E. 15.9 ft.; scribed 1/4 S4 BT RE 2311.

12" Fir bears N4°W. 10.7 ft.; scribed 1/4 S5 BT.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 12" Fir BT. Set $4\times4\times60$ white painted cedar post 1 ft. NW of pipe
