One Quarter corner common to Sections 5 and 8, T.3N., R.6W., W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

## ORIGINAL

24" x 18" x 18" stone (now in place with cross on top, 1/4 on N. face, and a  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48" iron pipe on SE edge), from which a:

4" Fir bears N74°E 105 lks.; now 38" stump, portion of scribe visible, rest unexposed.
48" Fir bears S39°E 35 lks.; now 48" snag, scribes 1/4 S visible, rest unexposed.

## RESTORED

Erected mound of stone around above pipe and south side of 1/4 stone, from which a:

14" Hemlock bears S62°E 21.7 ft.; scribed 1/4 S8 BT.
12" Noble Fir bears N51°E 29.0 ft.; scribed 1/4 S5
BT RS401.

Oregon State Board of Forestry metal location poster on 12" Noble Fir BT.

Set 4" x 4" x 60" white painted cedar post 2.0' SW.
